Entitlement

A single family pass shall admit 1 Adult and own children under 14 years to the Association's grounds during the Annual show, day and night. A family pass shall admit 2 Adults and their children under 14 years to the Association's grounds during the Annual Show, day and night. Note: Family Passes will be classed as a Membership to the Association – this will entitle the holder to attend and vote at the AGM.

HORSE EVENTS

REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- All entries in Ring Events must be made during the show by the competitor simply purchasing a ticket for each class he/she wishes to compete in. (A camping fee will also be collected when competitors are paying nomination fees.) Tickets will be available from the Ring Office in the Centre Ring. Purchased tickets are not refundable under any circumstances.
- The Bowen Pastoral and Agricultural Association Inc reserves the right to make any deletions, inclusions or changes to this program/schedule.
- Competitors are advised not to approach the Chief Ring Steward for alterations to the Program/Schedule to be made as none will be made.
- When the class is called into the ring, the ticket must be given to the Steward assisting the Judge.
- Under no circumstances is a competitor or supporter to approach the Judge or the Stewards on a ruling/decision etc. Such should be directed to the Chief Ring Steward only.
- The age of the horse shall be calculated from August 1st in any year and shall be deemed 1 year old.
- Horses must be free from hereditary unsoundness in all classes except jumping events.
- Horses to be paraded on the day at the times/places as directed by the Stewards.
- LOCAL – refers to the original Bowen Shire
- Maiden – any horse that at the time of starting has never won a first prize in any similar or same competition.
- Novice – horses that have not won a championship
- Pony - under 14 hands
- Galloway – 14 to 15 hands
- Horse – over 15 hands
- The Chief Ring Steward reserves the right to measure any horse, pony or galloway should there be some doubt about the measurement of the animal.
- Any exhibitor/competitor not in attendance when called by the Ring Master/ Steward, shall not be judged. Competitors are strongly advised to make careful decisions about which events will be entered due to 4 Rings operating, the time and logistical constraints of a one day show. No ring shall be required to wait for a competitor who is competing in another ring.
- All competitors and horses in graded events must be registered members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia or graded with PCAQ.
- Jumping : All events will be judged under E.F.A rules, horses in graded events must be registered with E.F.A. PERFORMANCE CARDS must be produced before competition will be allowed. All jumping events will be decided over a course and obstacles as stewards direct. All riders in jumping events must wear formal hunting attire to the approval of the stewards. Junior riders may NOT compete in both AGE and Graded Events on the same horse. Ability show jumping for riders under the age of 14 yrs and under 17yrs are for the encouragement of junior riders. In these classes riders must only nominate one horse. Disclaimer notice must be signed by all junior riders nominated in these two classes. Any registered horses may jump but must jump HC
- In jumping classes all riders must wear protective headwear and be suitably attired. The use of a whip with a lash by an exhibitor/competitor is strictly prohibited.
- All ponies are to be ridden by persons under 17 years of age unless otherwise stated. Birth Certificates to be produced if demanded by Stewards.
- All stallions may compete in jumping classes but not in riding or hack classes unless otherwise stated in the program.
- All stallions must be properly supervised at all times whilst on the grounds; bit and chain for led-in classes. There are no stallion stalls on the grounds but arrangements can be made with the Secretary.
- Judges shall decline to make awards where entries are of insufficient merit.
- Any horse entered in a 'led-in' class must have proof of registration of the breed and this must be available for inspection if necessary by the Chief Ring Steward.
- NOMINATIONS and Stalls and electric fences will be required to be paid for before you nominate by registering your name and number of horses
- Horse stalls can be booked through the Chief Horse Steward. \$5.50 per stall; \$2 per electric fence area (4m x 4m max);
- Camping Fees \$13.50. No electric fences are to be erected without prior arrangements with Caretaker or Chief Horse Steward.

- **ENTRY INTO RINGS** : Ticket System. NO TICKET NO ENTRY
- Registered papers may be required by the Chief Ring Steward
- All placings from breed classes will be forwarded to their Associations where you must hold current membership and the exhibit to be registered with that Breed Association to be eligible to exhibit horse/pony
- Local showjumping class : Rider and Horse must have been a resident of the Whitsunday Shire for a minimum of six months (Indemnity forms must be signed by parent before entry into the Local Jump
- Local Pony, Galloway & Hack Class : are to be resident and horse of Bowen Shire for a period of 6 months or more.
- Because of WORK PLACE HEALTH & SAFETY no livestock can be treated for ticks on the Showgrounds. All return treatments will be carried out on at the tick line. It is the responsibility of anyone travelling stock to tick frees areas to make their arrangements with Inspectors at these centres
- DRUGS : The use of hormones and/or tranquilisers is prohibited. Any exhibitors violating this regulation will be dealt with by the Bowen Show Society and Chief Ring Steward. Veterinarian will be in attendance or on call.
- Junior riders under 17yrs to wear jodphurs boots only, in all rider classes, pony hack classes and junior hack classes.
- Led Classes : If you have entered in a breed class you are not eligible to enter in any other breed
- Stallions must be only ridden and handled by adults (18yrs and over) and apply the 2011 EA rules for stallions at competitions
- Riders compete at their own risk. Neither the organising committee or persons involved in the running of the competition on **Tuesday 28th June 2011** shall be responsible for the loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever whilst on the Bowen Showgrounds.
